A Special meeting of the Newbury Township Board of Trustees, was called to order on Wednesday, April 15, 2020 at 7:01 p.m., with Bill Skomrock and Greg Tropf present, and Glen Quigley in attendance via teleconference as allowed by Governor DeWine's revision to the Ohio Open Meetings Act.

Mr. Skomrock opened a discussion to change the township's meetings to only once per month in order to comply with Governor DeWine's directive for social distancing.

Mr. Tropf made the motion to meet once per month

Newbury Fire Chief Ken Fagan was unable to attend, however he submitted that the Fire Department responded to 23 fire/rescue calls for the month of March, and 169 calls year to date.

Fiscal officer, Bev Sustar, presented the March Bank Reconciliation and supporting financial reports.

Receipts for March: \$267,352.39 Payments \$181,511.69

Checking and investment balances totaled 1,843,039.23 effective Mach 31, 2020

ODNR NatureWorks reimbursing grant funds were received, in the amount of \$11,669. Receipt was presented.

Resolution 20200415-01 was presented to appropriate the funds receipted.

The \$4,000 is to pay back the transfer from the General Fund last year.

Mr. Tropf moved to approve the resolution

Mr. Quigley seconded the motion

Chairman Skomrock presented bids for proposed various road improvements Bids were received from Chagrin Valley Paving, Ronyak Paving, Karvo Companies and Empire Paving. Correspondence from the County Engineer Joe Cattell's office recommended Chagrin Valley Paving as the lowest and best bid.

Trustee Quigey moved to approve the contract to Chagrin Valley Paving

Chairman Skomrock seconded the motion

Voice vote: Quigley - yes, Skomrock - yes,, with Trustee Tropf abstaining

Ms. Sustar will forward documents along with an award letter to the winning bidder. She also confirmed that there sufficient appropriations unencumbered to open a purchase order when the signed contract is received.

Mr. Skomrock informed the other trustees that the NOPEC grant for \$1500 has been approved. NOPEC instructed that do to uncertain circumstances they suggest not specifying a purpose for the grant at this time.

Road Superintendent, Doug Zimperman gave a status of the road department. GovDeals sent confirmation that the vehicle placed at auction had sold. After administrative fees retained by GovDeals, the net sale is expected to be approximately \$8,500.00.

Mr. Skomrock presented quotes for spring clean up and seasonal maintenance for townshsip owned properties including the Fire Station, the Town Hall, the American Legion hall and Veterans Park. Included was a separate quote for repair to existing landscaping at the main entrance to the Town Hall. Discussion of upgrading town hall retaining wall from landscape timbers to more permanent stone.

Trustee Quigley moved to accept the bids from Scape-Abilites for spring and regular maintenance Trustee Tropf seconded the motion

Voice vote: Quigley - yes, Tropf - yes, Skomrock - yes

Mr. Skomrock will request a revised quote for stone retaining wall and upgraded plantings for Town Hall

Mr. Skomrock gave the monthly sheriff's report of 153 calls for March.

Mr. Quigley would like to apply for another NatureWorks grant for 2020 for waterless restrooms at Oberland Park. Application is due by June. Construction is a prefab waterless design similar to those currently used by the Geauga Park District. He would look into cost. The company is already state bid approved. He would also check with the Park Board to see if they are on agreement.

He suggested that Chagrin River Watershed Partnership be used again to administer the grant at a cost of approximately \$1,200-\$1,500.

Geauga Trumbull Solid Waste District is offering grant opportunities.

Mr. Quigley checked with them to see if purchase and placement of benches made of recycled materials would qualify for their <u>Got To Go Green</u> grant. They have agreed that it would qualify.

Mr. Quigley moved to go forward with the grant application

Mr. Tropf seconded the motion

Voice vote: Quigley - yes, Tropf - yes, Skomrock - yes

GTSWD has another <u>Got To Go Green</u> grant that could cover the cost of a concrete pad at the recycling area across from the American Legion. It would cut down on the mud issue in that area.

Mr. Quigley moved to go forward with the grant application

Mr. Tropf seconded the motion

Voice vote: Quigley - yes, Tropf - yes, Skomrock - yes

Mr. Quigley stated that he has become aware of community grant through Home Depot and Lowes Home Improvement. The grants take to form of a store gift card. Mr. Skomrock suggested that Mr. Quigley check into that, and also check into other local hardware type stores to see if they would be interested.

Two resolutions to go forward with the Disposition of properties were presented. Both Properties have been deemed health and safety concerns. Attempts to engage property owners in bringing the properties into compliance have not been successful.

Discussion moved to: proposed changes in specifications for roads in new subdivisions. The purposes of changes is to hold builders and developers responsible for quality of roads that would ultimately be turned over to the townships for ongoing maintenance and repair.
