January 10, 2019,

Meeting called to order at 7:32 p.m. after a pizza dinner for Carole's last day

Minutes of November read by Carol and approved.

Due to Carol's and Roger's resignations two open board positions have been posted in the paper. Jim agreed to be chairman.

Oberland Park:

A*Carol reported Kiwanis voted to provide ice cream for summer concert on June 14.

*Glen passed around examples of restrooms from CXT recommended by the Geauga Park District. This company is on the state bidding process for governments so will not have to go out for bid. They will deliver it on a truck to the site. A double wide was suggested due to the number of kids using during games. Location was discussed, should be out in the open due to tall vent stacks, need easy access for the truck. Triangle was suggested. Applications are due by February 1st. Glen has contacted Marty Sanders on the number of kids in the rec program, question was raised about future of ball fields with the schools merging. Judy will provide esthetical value of the park. Glen will contact Chagrin river watershed partners for better language to use in the application. Marcia is willing to take on some of the grant paperwork to save on expenses.

*The skate track was brought up if it was still being investigated. Mark has someone who is interested in putting in a bocce ball court instead.

Veterans Park

Tree planting

\$9000 was budgeted for the trail paving project. Left over money approximately \$4000 can be used to purchase trees, possibly from Impulliti or Van Curren. It will cost about the same to use a tree spade to move trees from Oberland Park to Veterans Park. Judy will give Glen a list of native trees to be planted down the center of the walkway from the gazebo to the flag poles.
