1. The Meeting was called to order at 7:10 PM.

- 3. Ladie Lubonovich discussed proposed plans for construction and installation of a sign near the driveway entrance of Veterans Park. The sign will be two-sided and made in the shape of a Pentagon. The sign denoting Newbury Township Veterans Memorial Park will be emblazoned with an American Eagle and furled flag. It will include artwork representative of the Service Branches. The sign will be supported using vinyl-clad wood posts sunk in concrete. Representative drawings were shown to the members. Ladie participated in the discussion and addressed questions. Designs by Dianna will be invited to offer design expertise to the production of the sign.
