Meeting called to order at 7:05 p.m., minutes of August meeting read and approved with minor corrections.

Park board positions:

Carol was officially appointed to the Park Board at the last trustee meeting

Oberland Park.

Trustees are looking into the Conservation Easement. Les has been in contact with Bret Rodstrom who is sending a conservation easement. Wayne is out of town next week, a meeting was scheduled to review the conservation easement proposal for Monday, September 25 at 7:00 p.m. Glen will make sure it is put in the paper.

-Need material to seal the entrance rock.

-Evan from Impullitti tree asked about funding for the skate park, wants to put up a sign stating future home of..

Veterans Park

-Impullitti is done with their portion of the project Glen will review with them a few minor issues to be addressed.

-100 perennials and 20 trees were donated and planted. Dan found a service who will water the plants.

-Need to put down wood chips between evergreens to protect from mowers.

-Independent tree provided fertilizer and bed work for the trees, will maintain trees in the future, they donated the big logs and chain saw work.

-A woman sent a check for a tree to be planted in her husband's name, who went to Newbury.

-In future will have a process for buying bricks for the walkway

-Glen working on grants from Lowes and Home Depot.

-Jim suggested using the grant money to buy a mower to take care of beds

-Geauga feed store donated the grass seed, need to schedule a work day to spread seed.
