The regular meeting of Newbury Township Trustees called to order at 7:02 p.m., June 16, 2021, with Bill Skomrock and Greg Tropf in attendance at the town hall. Trustees Glen Quigley was not in attendance.

Mr. Skomrock opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Skomrock indicated that the purchase agreement for the Grange Park property needs to be signed. He reminded all that proceeds should be used for park purposes. Bill and Greg both signed. Mr. Quigley will need to come to town hall to sign.

Ms. Sustar requested the approval of minutes from regular meeting June 2, 2021 and June 10, 2021. Motion to approve minutes was made by Mr. Skomrock, 2nd by Mr. Tropf. Voice vote: two ayes, one absent.

Fiscal officer presented resolution 20210616-01 to certify costs associated with removal of unsafe structure on Portlew. Resolution will be submitted to Geauga County Auditor's office for Tax Year 2021 collection.

Also presented was resolution 20210616-02 declaring it necessary to place a renewal levy on the ballot at the November general election. Mr. Skomrock moved the adoption of the resolution, Mr. Tropf seconded the motion.

Voice vote: two ayes, one absent.

Mr. Tropf said that Doug Zimperman sent revised Road Budget. He is pretty sure that Newbury Township will receive Ohio Public Works Commission funding to assist with the paving project for Music Street in 2022. Budget has been advertised, is available for review in the administration office, and will be voted on at the first meeting in July.

The Fire Department would like to meet with the trustees to discuss building addition and full-time staffing. Both trustees in attendance and the fiscal officer are available to meet with Fire Department Board on June 30, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.

A complaint was received from a resident on Whitewood regarding someone shooting in their backyard. Mr. Skomrock asked that resident be good neighbors and be considerate. There are children and pets as well as veterans who become upset around gun fire and fireworks.

Mr. Tropf brought up the ongoing problems with the cemetery. Foundations are not being poured , deeds are incorrect and files are missing. Mr. Tropf would like to have an executive session at one of the trustees next meetings to discuss problems and solutions.

Jim Stefancin spoke on behalf of the Park Board. He said the Bocce ball courts are ready for the scouts to finish up. He complimented the road department on their work. He also wanted to thank Arms Trucking for the donation of stone for drainage.

Members of the Park Board installed 2 benches at Veterans Park. One of the benches is located in from of the memorial stone.

John Suvak has completed the installation of the stone retaining wall in front of the Town Hall. Some perennials have been planted.

Mr. Skomrock gave an update on the prior Newbury High School building. He will know more with Marous Brothers gives their opinion on the costs associated with partial demolition and reconstruction of the building. What is the economic impact of the township retaining the building.

Kiwanis Lake Road complaints. Some roads have not been officially abandoned, but are being used as extensions of adjacent property. This will need further discussion, once more information is obtained.

Mr. Fagan reported calls for the month of May was 55. So far in the month of June there were 26 calls and year to date there have been 276 calls.

OPWC elections for representatives for our district are open for nominations. Mr.Cavanagh, trustee from Auburn Township, is currently the representative for our state road district. He is open to srving another term.
