Mr. Tropf's updates:

Mr. Tropf will meet with Milano Monuments representative on the 10th to discuss this year's headstone restoration.

The construction contract with Integrity Construction has been forwarded to Atty Fitzsimmons for review.

ODOT confirms that signs can be installed.

First the township must pass a resolution banning engine brakes. Second, signs on State Routes need to be provided by township, but the state will install.

Mr. Quigley updates:

Memorial Day parade will begin at Oberland Park and finish with services at Newbury Center Cemetery. It will also be celebrated with a brass band and picnic at Veterans Park.

Grant for mural at recycling site deadline for completion has been extended. Looking for an artist.

Restrooms at Oberland Park. Mr. Quigley is still in favor of waterless prefab facility. Discussion of need to add water source to park, with or without restroom. Cost of septice/or can we tie into sewer plant at previous school property.

Mr. Skomrock gave the Sheriff's Office report for April. There were 164 calls, including traffic stops.

Oberland Park Pavilion: need to confirm that facility is left in good order. Suggest users forward picture from their phone at the end of use. Would include date and time that picture was taken, without having the admin drive to pavilion to personally inspect.

Suggest that someone from park board manage pavilion and park use to upload to township website.

Cleveland Disc Association asked to use soccer fields. Glen will check with soccer federation for conflicts.

Leadership Geauga has also asked to use park with trailer.

Mr. Skomrock spoke about former school property. West Geauga School Board passed a resolution to decline Newbury Task Force counter proposal and to end negotiations. Mr. Skomrock voiced his frustration and disappointment. But stated that he is not ready to give up.
