## **Newbury Township Spring Clean-Up Day**

The Newbury Township annual spring clean-up day will be held from 7 AM to 2 PM - on June 7<sup>th</sup> 2025.

Drop off will be at the Newbury Township Service Department, located at 11008 Kinsman Road, entering between the recycling area and the Legion Post #663. Exiting will be between the Geauga Feed Store and our front building.

### **Newbury Residents Only - identification will be required.**

**ITEMS THAT WILL BE ACCEPTED:** Tires – limit of 6. Metal items, appliances, empty oil tanks, televisions, and electronic equipment. Plastic, toys, furniture, appliances, electronics, grills, sports equipment. Building materials that are a manageable size.

**Any cloth or fabric materials like a couch, chairs, bedding, mattresses are required to be wrapped in plastic or a disposable furniture bag. If they are not wrapped, they will not be taken.**

### **ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED:**

- **Rocks, dirt, brush, yard waste, tree trunks, branches or brush.**
- **ANY LIQUIDS – including paints, chemicals, pesticides, anti-freeze, oils of any types – including motor oils.**
- **Municipal, hazardous, or industrial waste.**
- **Plastic coated wire.**
- **Construction debris.**
- **Household garbage.**

Paper, cardboard, metal cans, plastic recyclables can be placed in the recycle bins any time. Please do not include normal recyclables; please follow recycling guidelines.
