

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

The special meeting of the Board of Trustees of Newbury Township was called to order at 8:01 a.m. on May 16, 2026, at the Newbury Township Town Hall. Chairman Gregory Tropf, and Trustees David Lair, Jr. and Carly Sayre were in attendance. Also in attendance were Fiscal Officer Lindsay Pollock and Road Superintendent, Doug Ziperman.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss and plan for the 2027 budget and to address any regular business arising since the last regular meeting.

Topics discussed included:

- Paving projects, OPWC grant, priorities
- Equipment needs
- Loan paydown
- Possible improvements – concrete bins at service garage, electronic sign outside town hall, signage at the park to indicate ball field numbers, cremains mausoleum at center cemetery
- Possible snow plowing subcontractors

Ms. Sayre confirmed with the other trustees that an exemption may be allowed to Stephen Gray's plot at Munn Cemetery. Mr. Lair and Mr. Tropf agreed. Ms. Sayre to follow up with an exception form for the resident to sign.

Mr. Lair moved to accept the bid from Ronyak Paving for the 2026 paving projects and Ms. Sayre seconded. Roll call vote: Lair – yes, Sayre – yes, Tropf – abstain.

Mr. Tropf moved to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Lair. Meeting was adjourned at 10:03 a.m. by unanimous vote.
